WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Creates a service delivery technical assistance program within the Governor's office for the purpose of providing assistance to counties in fiscal distress. The program would award and administer grants to state, local and special governmental bodies for service delivery innovation; enter into agreements with public and private entities to provide technical assistance to public bodies; and convene task forces and workgroups as needed.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:
