WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the Department of Corrections to continue to enter into contracts with other public entities to send Oregon inmates to their corrections facilities to January 2, 2018.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Applies when prisons are overcrowded
- Does not apply to transfer of inmates under Interstate Compact when the Department of Corrections transfers the inmate to another state for the inmate's safety

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Currently the Oregon Department of Corrections has the statutory authority to contract with out-ofstate public entities. The department does so contract when faced with prison overcrowding. This statutory authority expires on January 2, 2014.
