

House Bill 2005

Sponsored by Representative KOTEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt amendments to state building code establishing mechanical insulation standards applicable to industrial buildings.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to energy efficiency; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to any amendments adopted under the provisions of ORS 455.500,**
5 **455.505 and 455.511, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall**
6 **adopt amendments to the state building code under ORS 455.030 to increase energy efficiency**
7 **in industrial buildings by establishing mechanical insulation standards applicable to all in-**
8 **dustrial buildings in this state.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
