

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2005

By COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 40 through 45 and delete page 3 and in-  
2 sert:

3 “**SECTION 5.** ORS 455.140 is amended to read:

4 “455.140. (1) There is established a Mechanical Board consisting of [*nine*] **10** members appointed  
5 by the Governor.

6 “(2) The members of the board shall assist the Director of the Department of Consumer and  
7 Business Services in administering the code adopted pursuant to ORS 455.020 for mechanical devices  
8 and equipment.

9 “(3) The board must consist of:

10 “(a) One representative of the plumbing industry;

11 “(b) One sheet metal and air conditioner contractor;

12 “(c) One municipal mechanical inspector possessing the highest level of mechanical inspector  
13 certification issued by the Department of Consumer and Business Services;

14 “(d) One heating, venting and air conditioning contractor;

15 “(e) One heating, venting and air conditioning installer;

16 “(f) One sheet metal and air conditioner installer;

17 “(g) One representative of a natural gas company or other utility;

18 “(h) One building official; [*and*]

19 “**(i) One insulation craftsperson who has experience with heat and frost insulation; and**

20 “[*i*] **(j) One public member who does not receive compensation from any interest represented**  
21 **under paragraphs (a) to [*h*] (i) of this subsection.**

22 “(4) At least one of the board members described in subsection (3)(b) or (d) of this section must  
23 be an owner or operator of a contracting business employing 10 or fewer persons at the time of the  
24 member’s appointment to the term.

25 “**SECTION 6. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is repealed January 2, 2015.**

26 “**SECTION 7. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
27 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
28 **on its passage.”**
