

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2025**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 5.** ORS 607.992 is amended to read:

3 **“607.992. (1)** *[Violation of any provision of this chapter is a misdemeanor.]* **A person that in-**
4 **tentionally, knowingly or recklessly violates a provision of this chapter is guilty of a Class**
5 **A misdemeanor.**

6 **“(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a person that violates a provision**
7 **of this chapter, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or recklessly, commits a Class B**
8 **violation.**

9 **“(3)(a) A person that violates ORS 607.045, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or**
10 **recklessly, commits a Class D violation if the person does not have a previous conviction for**
11 **a violation of ORS 607.045. As used in this paragraph, ‘previous conviction’ means a con-**
12 **viction entered before the commission of the current violation of ORS 607.045.**

13 **“(b) Notwithstanding ORS 153.019 or any other requirement pertaining to Class D vio-**
14 **lation fine amounts, the presumptive fine for a violation described in this subsection is**
15 **\$60.”.**
