3	"607.992. (1) [Violation of any provision of this chapter is a misdemeanor.] A person that in
4	tentionally, knowingly or recklessly violates a provision of this chapter is guilty of a Class
5	A misdemeanor.
6	"(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a person that violates a provision
7	of this chapter, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or recklessly, commits a Class I
8	violation.
9	"(3)(a) A person that violates ORS 607.045, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or
10	recklessly, commits a Class D violation if the person does not have a previous conviction for
11	a violation of ORS 607.045. As used in this paragraph, 'previous conviction' means a con
12	viction entered before the commission of the current violation of ORS 607.045.
13	"(b) Notwithstanding ORS 153.019 or any other requirement pertaining to Class D vio
14	lation fine amounts, the presumptive fine for a violation described in this subsection is
15	\$60. ".
