

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2032

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete line 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “(3) No later than December 1 of each year, the Director of the Department of State Lands shall
3 submit to the Legislative Assembly and the State Land Board a detailed report that specifies:

4 “(a) The costs and expenses related to off-site compensatory mitigation, including variations and
5 trends in costs and expenses over time.

6 “(b) Efforts undertaken by the department to reduce the costs and expenses specified in para-
7 graph (a) of this subsection.

8 “(c) Efforts undertaken by the department to improve efficiencies of the department related to
9 off-site compensatory mitigation.

10 “(d) The effectiveness of the July 2010 ‘Oregon Rapid Wetland Assessment Protocol’ of the de-
11 partment in protecting the functions and values of wetlands through off-site compensatory miti-
12 gation.

13 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the amendments to
14 ORS 196.643 by section 1 of this 2013 Act become operative on January 1, 2014.**

15 **“(2) The Department of State Lands may adopt rules before the operative date specified
16 in subsection (1) of this section, or take any other actions before the operative date specified
17 in subsection (1) of this section, that are necessary to implement, on or after the operative
18 date specified in subsection (1) of this section, the amendments to ORS 196.643 by section 1
19 of this 2013 Act.**

20 **“SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 196.643 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to
21 payments for off-site compensatory mitigation made to the Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation
22 Fund on or after the operative date specified in section 2 of this 2013 Act.**

23 **“SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
24 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
25 on its passage.”.**
