

# House Bill 2057

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Oregon Liquor Control Commission)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands membership of Alcohol Server Education Advisory Committee to include two educators and two representatives of alcohol server education providers.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Alcohol Server Education Advisory Committee; amending ORS 471.547.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 471.547 is amended to read:

5 471.547. **(1)** The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall establish an Alcohol Server Education  
6 Advisory Committee [*consisting of persons representing the commission, the Oregon State Police, the*  
7 *Oregon District Attorneys Association, the Oregon Health Authority, the Department of Transportation,*  
8 *at least one person who is a service permittee under ORS 471.360, a nonprofit organization the purpose*  
9 *of which is to reduce the incidence of drunk driving, and not more than three associations representing*  
10 *retail licensees and two associations representing insurance companies to assist in:*]

11 [*(1) The development of*]. **The advisory committee shall consist of the following members:**

12 **(a) One person who represents the commission.**

13 **(b) One person who represents the Oregon State Police.**

14 **(c) One person who represents the Oregon District Attorneys Association.**

15 **(d) One person who represents the Oregon Health Authority.**

16 **(e) One person who represents the Department of Transportation.**

17 **(f) One person who represents a nonprofit organization the purpose of which is to reduce**  
18 **the incidence of drunk driving.**

19 **(g) One person who has general expertise in education.**

20 **(h) One person who has expertise in health education.**

21 **(i) One person who represents classroom alcohol server education providers.**

22 **(j) One person who represents online alcohol server education providers.**

23 **(k) At least one person who is a service permittee under ORS 471.360.**

24 **(L) Not more than two persons who represent insurance companies.**

25 **(m) Not more than three persons who represent retail licensees.**

26 **(2) The purpose of the advisory committee is to assist in the development of:**

27 **(a)** The standards, curriculum and materials for the alcohol server education courses required  
28 under ORS 471.542;

29 **[(2)] (b)** The examination required by ORS 471.542, and procedures for administering that ex-  
30 amination;

31 **[(3)] (c)** The certification procedures, enforcement policies and penalties for alcohol server edu-

1 cation course instructors and providers; and

2 [(4)] (d) The [development of] time requirements for completion of an alcohol server education
