## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Reduces amount of time that appraisal management company has to make payment to independent contractor appraiser for completion of appraisal or appraisal review assignment.

2	Relating to appraisals; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 674.225.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 674.225 is amended to read:
5	674.225. Except in the case of breach of contract or substandard performance of real estate ap-
6	praisal activity, an appraisal management company shall make payment to an independent contrac-
7	tor appraiser for the completion of an appraisal or appraisal review assignment:
8	(1) Within [60] 30 days after the appraiser provides the completed appraisal report to the ap-
9	praisal management company; or
10	(2) In accordance with another payment schedule agreed to by the appraiser and the appraisal
11	management company.
12	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 674.225 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to pay-
13	ments for appraisal reports received by an appraisal management company on or after the
14	effective date of this 2013 Act.
