

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2104

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “688.415” insert “, 688.435”.
- 2 On page 2, delete lines 2 and 3 and insert:
- 3 “(b) ‘Ionizing radiation’ does not include nonionizing radiation.”.
- 4 In line 9, delete “other than a licensed physician, licensed”.
- 5 In line 10, delete “nurse practitioner or licensed physician assistant”.
- 6 In line 25, delete “licensed physician or a”.
- 7 After line 33, insert:
- 8 “(19) ‘Nonionizing radiation’ includes radiation such as radiofrequency or microwaves, visible,
- 9 infrared or ultraviolet light or ultrasound.”.
- 10 In line 34, delete “(19)” and insert “(20)”.
- 11 In line 37, delete “(20)” and insert “(21)”.
- 12 In line 39, delete “(21)” and insert “(22)”.
- 13 In line 42, delete “(22)” and insert “(23)”.
- 14 In line 44, delete “(23)” and insert “(24)”.
- 15 On page 3, line 3, delete “(24)” and insert “(25)”.
- 16 In line 6, delete “(25)” and insert “(26)”.
- 17 Delete lines 33 through 36 and insert:
- 18 “(B) Is ordered by a licensed physician, licensed physician assistant, licensed nurse practitioner,
- 19 certified registered nurse anesthetist, as defined in ORS 678.245, or other registered nurse licensed
- 20 under ORS chapter 678 who has been authorized by the Oregon State Board of Nursing to order a
- 21 medical imaging procedure; and
- 22 “(C) Is interpreted by a licensee described in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph who is acting
- 23 within the scope of the licensee’s authority.”.
- 24 Delete lines 40 through 42.
- 25 In line 43, delete “(b)” and insert “(2)”.
- 26 In line 44, delete “paragraph” and insert “subsection”.
- 27 After line 45, insert:
- 28 “**SECTION 3.** ORS 688.435 is amended to read:
- 29 “688.435. The provisions of ORS 688.405 to 688.605 do not apply to the following persons:
- 30 “(1) Persons who operate dental X-ray equipment for the sole purpose of oral radiography.
- 31 “(2) Students in approved schools, while practicing one of the medical imaging modalities or
- 32 subspecialties under the supervision of the school’s assigned clinical instructor.
- 33 “(3) Specific licensed health care providers, other than physicians, who use sonographic equip-
- 34 ment within their lawful scope of practice.
- 35 “(4) Licensed physicians.

1 “(5) Persons who use radiation for the purpose of research or education. As used in this
2 subsection:

3 “(a) ‘Education’ means a program of study or training:

4 “(A) In which a student, trainee or health care practitioner learns to practice or improve
5 skills for a profession regulated by a health professional regulatory board, as defined in ORS
6 676.160; and

7 “(B)(i) That is accredited by a national or regional post-secondary accrediting body or
8 organization; or

9 “(ii) That is approved or recognized by a health professional regulatory board, as defined
10 in ORS 676.160, for purposes related to being authorized to practice a profession.

11 “(b) ‘Research’ means systematic investigation, including research development, testing
12 and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to general knowledge and that has been
13 approved by an institutional review board that provides for the protection of human research
14 subjects in accordance with federal regulations.”.

15 On page 4, line 1, delete “3” and insert “4”.
