

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2118

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and delete
2 line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) There is created a nine-member health plan quality metrics work group,**
5 **consisting of:**

6 **“(a) One member appointed by the executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance**
7 **Exchange Corporation;**

8 **“(b) One member appointed by the Oregon Health Authority;**

9 **“(c) One member appointed by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board;**

10 **“(d) One member appointed by the Public Employees’ Benefit Board; and**

11 **“(e) Five members appointed by the executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance**
12 **Exchange Corporation, in consultation with the Director of the Oregon Health Authority, the**
13 **Oregon Educators Benefit Board and the Public Employees’ Benefit Board, including:**

14 **“(A) One individual with expertise in health care research;**

15 **“(B) One individual with expertise in health care quality measures;**

16 **“(C) One representative of insurers;**

17 **“(D) One representative of consumers of health care; and**

18 **“(E) One representative of a self-insured large employer.**

19 **“(2)(a) The work group shall publish recommendations for appropriate health outcomes**
20 **and quality measures to be used by the corporation, the authority and the boards. In devel-**
21 **oping the measures, the work group shall consider other state and national health outcomes**
22 **and quality measures and methodologies.**

23 **“(b) To the extent practicable, the work group shall recommend measures that further**
24 **the goals of the Oregon Integrated and Coordinated Health Care Delivery System while re-**
25 **cognizing the unique needs and goals of the corporation, the authority and the boards.**

26 **“(3) The work group shall utilize available health outcomes and quality measures and the**
27 **data systems for reporting the measures and minimize redundant reporting or the reporting**
28 **of data with limited value.**

29 **“(4) The work group shall develop a common format for collecting consumer responses**
30 **to the health quality measures and encourage the corporation, the authority and the boards**
31 **to publicly report the findings.**

32 **“(5)(a) The work group shall report its progress to the 2014 regular session of the Leg-**
33 **islative Assembly.**

34 **“(b) No later than May 31, 2014, the work group shall provide to the appropriate interim**
35 **committees of the Legislative Assembly a final report of the work group’s recommendations**

1 and any steps taken by the corporation, the authority and the boards to implement the rec-
2 ommendations.

3 “(6) The corporation shall provide staff support for the work group.

4 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed upon the convening of the 2015 regular
5 session of the Legislative Assembly.

6 “SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
8 on its passage.”

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
