

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2132

By COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE AND HUMAN SERVICES

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “creating new pro-  
2 visions;”.

3 In line 13, delete “and”.

4 After line 13, insert:

5 “(d) Efforts made, in collaboration with the Oregon Health Authority, to coordinate eligibility  
6 determination and enrollment processes for qualified health plans and the state medical assistance  
7 program; and”.

8 In line 14, delete “(d)” and insert “(e)”.

9 In line 22, restore the bracketed material.

10 Delete lines 23 through 25.

11 On page 2, line 1, restore the bracketed material and delete the boldfaced material.

12 After line 18, insert:

13 “**SECTION 3.** ORS 741.222, as amended by section 18, chapter 38, Oregon Laws 2012, section  
14 95, chapter 107, Oregon Laws 2012, and section 1 of this 2013 Act, is amended to read:

15 “741.222. (1) The executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation shall  
16 report to the Legislative Assembly each calendar quarter on:

17 “(a) The financial condition of the health insurance exchange, including actual and projected  
18 revenues and expenses of the administrative operations of the exchange and commissions paid to  
19 insurance producers out of fees collected under ORS 741.105 (5);

20 “(b) The implementation of the business plan adopted by the corporation board of directors;

21 “(c) The development of the information technology system for the exchange; **and**

22 “[*(d) Efforts made, in collaboration with the Oregon Health Authority, to coordinate eligibility de-*  
23 *termination and enrollment processes for qualified health plans and the state medical assistance pro-*  
24 *gram; and*]

25 “[*(e)*] **(d)** Any other information requested by the leadership of the Legislative Assembly.

26 “(2) The corporation board of directors shall provide to the Legislative Assembly, the Governor,  
27 the Oregon Health Authority, the Oregon Health Policy Board and the Department of Consumer and  
28 Business Services, not later than April 15 of each year:

29 “(a) A report covering the activities and operations of the corporation during the previous year  
30 of operations;

31 “(b) A statement of the financial condition, as of December 31 of the previous year, of the ac-  
32 counts established under ORS 741.101;

33 “(c) A description of the role of insurance producers in the exchange; and

34 “(d) Recommendations, if any, for additional groups to be eligible to purchase qualified health  
35 plans through the exchange under ORS 741.310.

1        **“SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 741.222 by section 3 of this 2013 Act become op-**  
2 **erative July 1, 2017.”.**

3        In line 19, delete “3” and insert “5”.
