

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2154

By COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 30.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The board of education of each community college district and the**
4 **president of each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall form an achievement compact**
5 **advisory committee.**

6 **“(2) Each achievement compact advisory committee shall be responsible for developing**
7 **an achievement compact.**

8 **“(3)(a) The board of education of a community college district or the president of a public**
9 **university shall appoint the members of an achievement compact advisory committee. The**
10 **members shall include administrators, faculty, education personnel and students of the**
11 **community college or public university.**

12 **“(b) For the purpose of selecting members of the achievement compact advisory com-**
13 **mittee, the president of the community college or the president of the public university shall:**

14 **“(A) Collaborate with any applicable employee associations of the community college or**
15 **public university to recommend persons who are full-time faculty and persons who are**
16 **part-time faculty; and**

17 **“(B) Collaborate with the student body government of the community college or public**
18 **university to recommend persons who are students of the community college or public uni-**
19 **versity.**

20 **“(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, if a community college or a public**
21 **university has a standing committee that includes representatives identified in subsection (3)**
22 **of this section, the board of education of the community college district or the president of**
23 **the public university may designate the standing committee as the achievement compact**
24 **advisory committee.**

25 **“(5) An achievement compact advisory committee shall:**

26 **“(a) Develop plans for achieving the outcomes, measures of progress, goals and targets**
27 **expressed in an achievement compact, including methods of assessing and reporting progress**
28 **toward the achievement of goals and targets; and**

29 **“(b) Recommend outcomes, measures of progress, goals and targets to be contained in**
30 **the achievement compact for the next fiscal year.**

31 **“(6)(a) Each achievement compact advisory committee shall present the recommen-**
32 **dations of the committee in a report to:**

33 **“(A) The board of education of the community college district no later than February 1**
34 **of each year; or**

35 **“(B) The president of the public university no later than a date identified by the president**

1 to comply with the timeline for submission of the achievement compact specified by the
2 Oregon Education Investment Board.

3 “(b) An achievement compact advisory committee’s report and recommendations shall
4 be considered by the board of education of the community college district or the president
5 of the public university when entering into an achievement compact for the next fiscal year.

6 “(c) The board of education of the community college district or the president of the
7 public university shall file the achievement compact advisory committee’s report with each
8 achievement compact that the board or president adopts and forwards to the Oregon Edu-
9 cation Investment Board.”.

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
