

House Bill 2155

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Higher Education)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs each public university to conduct study on how to better use campus resources during summer term and examine benefits of year-round, full-time operation of university.

Sunset study on January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to study of the operation of public universities; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall conduct a study of how**
5 **to better use campus resources during the summer term.**

6 **(2) The study must also examine the benefits of year-round full-time operation of the**
7 **university, including whether year-round, full-time operation would increase the utilization**
8 **of physical facilities on the university's campus and save on the general costs of higher ed-**
9 **ucation.**

10 **(3) The study must be reported to the Legislative Assembly or appropriate committee on**
11 **or before July 1, 2014.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
