## House Bill 2157

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Veterans Affairs)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish statewide policy to award college credit to veterans or persons serving in Armed Forces of United States for qualifying scores on college-level examination.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to a college-level examination program.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall establish a statewide policy for awarding veterans or persons serving in the Armed Forces of the United States academic credit at an institution of higher education based on a qualifying score from a college-level examination program.
    - (2) The commission shall:
- 9 (a) Collaborate and consult with each institution of higher education in developing the policy;
  - (b) Establish a standard qualifying score for each examination; and
  - (c) Set guidelines for each institution of higher education for awarding academic credit to veterans and persons serving in the Armed Forces of the United States in a manner that is consistent with the mission and admission standards of each institution of higher education.
  - (3) Each institution of higher education shall designate one person to determine whether a veteran or person serving in the Armed Forces of the United States enrolled at the institution of higher education qualifies for academic credit under the policy established by the commission.
    - (4) As used in this section:
- 21 (a) "Armed Forces of the United States" has the meaning given that term in ORS 348.282.
  - (b) "Institution of higher education" means:
- 23 (A) A public university listed in ORS 352.002.
  - (B) The Oregon Health and Science University.
- 25 (C) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341.
- 26 (D) A technical, professional or career school operating in this state.
- 27 (c) "Veteran" has the meaning given that term in ORS 408.225.
