SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Department of Human Services to provide certain information to Resident Safety Review Council no later than July 1, 2013.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to vulnerable persons; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2013, the Department of Human Services shall provide to the Resident Safety Review Council created under section 14, chapter 70, Oregon Laws 2012, any information or reports from investigations of abuse undertaken pursuant to ORS 124.070 or 441.650 that were not previously provided to the council under section 15, chapter 70, Oregon Laws 2012.
 - (2) Information and reports provided under subsection (1) of this section may not contain or reveal the name or other identifiable information regarding an alleged victim, a resident or any other person identified in the information or reports.
 - <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
