

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2207

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “creating new provisions; and”.

2 Delete lines 25 through 27 and insert:

3 “(b) The department shall electronically provide itemized statements of payroll deductions to the
4 recipient.

5 “(c) If the department determines that electronic payment of net salary and wages is not prac-
6 ticable or efficient, payment may be made by paper check or by a credit to a bank-issued payroll
7 card.

8 “(d) Notwithstanding paragraph (b) of this subsection, if an officer or employee wants to receive
9 payment of net salary and wages by check or to receive a paper statement of itemized payroll de-
10 ductions, the officer or employee shall request paper statements or payment by check in accordance
11 with the procedures adopted by rule by the department.”.

12 On page 2, line 6, delete “Unpresented”.

13 In line 7, delete the boldfaced material and insert “Payments not transferred to the person en-
14 titled to receive the payment”.

15 On page 3, line 29, after “provided” insert “electronically”.

16 In line 30, delete “to” and insert a period.

17 Delete line 31 and insert:

18 “(d) State agencies shall provide access to electronic statements to employees who do not have
19 regular access to computers in their workplace.

20 “(e) Notwithstanding paragraph (c) of this subsection, if an officer or employee paid under the
21 state payroll system as provided by ORS 292.026 wants to receive payment of net salary and wages
22 by check or to receive a paper statement of itemized payroll deductions, the officer or employee
23 shall request paper statements or payment by check in accordance with the procedures adopted by
24 rule by the department.”.

25 On page 4, after line 21, insert:

26 “**SECTION 6. The amendments to ORS 292.026, 292.032, 292.033, 652.110 and 652.610 by**
27 **sections 1 to 5 of this 2013 Act become operative on January 1, 2014.**

28 “**SECTION 7. The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services may**
29 **take any action before the operative date specified in section 6 of this 2013 Act that is nec-**
30 **essary to enable the department to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in**
31 **section 6 of this 2013 Act, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department**
32 **by this 2013 Act.”.**

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
