

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2207
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “and”.

2 In line 3, before the period insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 In line 23, after the period delete the rest of the line and lines 24 and 25.

4 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 5 and insert:

5 “(c) If the department determines that the electronic payment of net salary and wages is not
6 practicable or efficient, payment may be made by:

7 “(A) Paper check; or

8 “(B) A credit to a bank-issued payroll card if the employee consents to payment by a bank-issued
9 payroll card that is made in accordance with 12 C.F.R. 1005.5 as in effect on the effective date of
10 this 2013 Act.”.

11 On page 4, after line 43, insert:

12 “**SECTION 6a. If House Bill 2683 becomes law, section 4 of this 2013 Act (amending ORS
13 652.110) is repealed.**

14 “**SECTION 6b.** If House Bill 2683 becomes law, section 6 of this 2013 Act is amended to read:

15 “**Sec. 6.** The amendments to ORS 292.026, 292.032, 292.033[*652.110*] and 652.610 by sections 1
16 to **3 and 5** of this 2013 Act become operative on January 1, 2014.”.

17 On page 5, after line 3, insert:

18 “**SECTION 8. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
20 on its passage.**”.
