CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the transportation of onions; amending ORS 632.236; and repealing ORS 632.241.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 632.241 is repealed.

SECTION 2. ORS 632.236 is amended to read:

632.236. [(1)] Unlabeled onions may be transported for [a distance of less than 50 miles on a] sale or delivery to:

[(a)] (1) A warehouse or other facility for grading or storage;[.]

[(b)] (2) A livestock feeder for feeding purposes; **or**[.]

[(2) Upon written permit of the State Department of Agriculture issued under ORS 632.241, unlabeled onions may be transported:]

[(a)] (3) [To] A processing plant.

[(b) For distances of 50 miles or more to a livestock feeder for feeding purposes, or to a warehouse or other facility for grading or storage.]
