

House Bill 2245

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for State Department of Agriculture)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates permit requirement for transporting unlabeled onions 50 or more miles.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the transportation of onions; amending ORS 632.236; and repealing ORS 632.241.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 632.241 is repealed.

SECTION 2. ORS 632.236 is amended to read:

632.236. *[(1)]* Unlabeled onions may be transported for *[a distance of less than 50 miles on a]* sale or delivery to:

[(a)] **(1)** A warehouse or other facility for grading or storage; *].*

[(b)] **(2)** A livestock feeder for feeding purposes; **or** *].*

[(2)] *Upon written permit of the State Department of Agriculture issued under ORS 632.241, unlabeled onions may be transported:]*

[(a)] **(3)** *[To]* A processing plant.

[(b)] *For distances of 50 miles or more to a livestock feeder for feeding purposes, or to a warehouse or other facility for grading or storage.]*

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
