## House Bill 2257

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Water Resources Department)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows Water Resources Department, upon request, to amend water right certificate to change names and addresses on certificate.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the amendment of personal information displayed on a water right certificate; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 537.
  - SECTION 2. (1) The holder of a water right certificate may file a request with the Water Resources Department that the certificate be amended to change one or more of the names or addresses displayed on the certificate. If the department grants a request made under this section, the amendments to the water right certificate must be limited to changes in the names or addresses displayed on the certificate and the issue date for the certificate as amended. The amended water right certificate must display the name and address of the holder of the certificate. The amendment of a water right certificate under this section does not affect the priority date of the water right or otherwise affect the terms, contents or elements of the water right.
  - (2) The department may charge a reasonable fee for the issuance of an amended water right certificate under this section.
  - (3) The Water Resources Commission may adopt rules for the carrying out of this section, including but not limited to rules for the submission and processing of water right certificate amendment requests and for the charging of fees under subsection (2) of this section.
  - <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
