

House Bill 2313

Sponsored by Representative READ (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires insurer to provide process for nurse practitioner practicing in rural or frontier area to earn same reimbursement paid to primary care physician.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reimbursement of nurse practitioner services; amending ORS 743A.036.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.036 is amended to read:

5 743A.036. (1) Whenever any policy of health insurance provides for reimbursement for any ser-
6 vice which is within the lawful scope of practice of a duly licensed and certified nurse practitioner,
7 including prescribing or dispensing drugs, the insured under the policy is entitled to reimbursement
8 for such service whether it is performed by a physician licensed by the Oregon Medical Board or
9 by a duly licensed nurse practitioner.

10 **(2) An insurer shall provide a process through which a nurse practitioner may obtain the**
11 **same reimbursement for a service that the insurer pays to a primary care physician for the**
12 **service if:**

13 **(a) The nurse practitioner maintains an independent primary care practice in a rural or**
14 **frontier area, as designated by the Office of Rural Health; and**

15 **(b) No licensed primary care physician is practicing in a location that is less than 15**
16 **miles from the location of the practice of the nurse practitioner.**

17 [(2)] **(3) This section does not apply to group practice health maintenance organizations that are**
18 **federally qualified pursuant to Title XIII of the Health Maintenance Organization Act or to nurse**
19 **practitioners employed by or in a professional services contract with a licensed health care**
20 **facility, ambulatory surgical center or physician's office.**
