## A-Engrossed House Bill 2334

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Modifies [crimes] **crime** of [promoting prostitution and] compelling prostitution. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to prostitution; creating new provisions; amending ORS 167.017; and declaring an emer-
3	gency.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 167.017 is amended to read:
6	167.017. (1) A person commits the crime of compelling prostitution if the person knowingly:
7	(a) Uses force or intimidation to compel another to engage in prostitution or attempted
8	prostitution;
9	(b) Induces or causes a person under 18 years of age to engage in prostitution;
10	(c) Aids or facilitates the commission of prostitution or attempted prostitution by a person
11	under 18 years of age; or
12	(d) Induces or causes the spouse, child or stepchild of the person to engage in prostitution.
13	(2) Compelling prostitution is a Class B felony.
14	(3) In a prosecution under subsection (1)(b) or (c) of this section, the state is not required to
15	prove that the defendant knew the other person was under 18 years of age and it is no defense that
16	the defendant did not know the person's age or that the defendant reasonably believed the person
17	to be older than 18 years of age.
18	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 167.017 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to con-
19	duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
20	SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
21	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
22	on its passage.
