House Bill 2341

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes Task Force on Funding Strategies for Oregon Public Education. Sunsets task force on date of convening of 2015 regular legislative session. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to education; and declaring an emergency.

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- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Task Force on Funding Strategies for Oregon Public Education is established.
 - (2) The task force consists of 13 members appointed as follows:
 - (a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from among members of the Senate.
 - (b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two members from among members of the House of Representatives.
 - (c) The Governor shall appoint nine members who represent school districts, education service districts, community colleges and public universities.
 - (3) The task force shall make recommendations regarding:
 - (a) The use of student outcomes or performances to determine funding for school districts, education service districts, community colleges and public universities.
 - (b) Possible modifications to the funding formulas used for school districts, education service districts, community colleges and public universities.
 - (c) The funding of early learning programs through community-based coordinators of early learning services.
 - (d) The use of strategic investments to support:
- 21 (A) Educator development;
 - (B) Involvement by parents and families of students;
- 23 (C) Early literacy;
 - (D) Success in science, technology, engineering and mathematics; and
 - (E) Integration of high school and post-secondary education.
- 26 (e) The strengthening of regional support for student achievement and educator devel-27 opment.
 - (4) When making the recommendations described in subsection (3) of this section, the task force must explain how the recommendations improve equity of and access to education.
 - (5) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the

transaction of business.

- (6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
 - (7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.
- (8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.
- (9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
 - (10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.
- (11) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no than October 1, 2014.
 - (12) The office of the Governor shall provide staff support to the task force.
- (13) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the task force who are members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage expenses or a per diem and serve as volunteers on the task force. Other members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.
- (14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force consider necessary to perform their duties.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
