SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study how state government services are delivered and develop proposals through which 10-year outcome-based planning may foster innovations in delivery of state government services.

Requires department to report to appropriate interim committees of Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly on or before October 1, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to state government.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall conduct a study of how state government services are delivered. The study must consider and develop proposals through which 10-year outcome-based planning may foster innovations in the delivery of these services.
 - (2) The department shall report its findings on or before October 1, 2014, to the interim committees of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly having jurisdiction over general government operations.
