

# House Bill 2347

Sponsored by Representative GREENLICK; Senator STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Transfers Bonny Slope from Multnomah County to Washington County.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the transfer of land from Multnomah County to Washington County; creating new pro-  
3 visions; amending ORS 201.260 and 201.340; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) That portion of Multnomah County constituting the southwest quarter**  
6 **of section 22, township 1 north, range 1 west of the Willamette Meridian, as described in**  
7 **subsection (2) of this section, is transferred to and made a part of Washington County.**

8 **(2) The area that is transferred under subsection (1) of this section is as follows: Begin-**  
9 **ning at the south quarter corner of section 22, that point also being on the south boundary**  
10 **of Multnomah County; thence north, following the east boundary of the southwest quarter**  
11 **of section 22 to the northeast corner of the southwest quarter of section 22; thence west,**  
12 **following the north boundary of the southwest quarter of section 22 to the northwest corner**  
13 **of the southwest quarter of section 22, that point also being the west quarter corner of**  
14 **section 22 and on the west boundary of Multnomah County; thence south, following the west**  
15 **boundary of section 22 to the southwest corner of section 22, that point also being a corner**  
16 **point on the west boundary of Multnomah County; thence east, following the south boundary**  
17 **of section 22, and the south boundary of Multnomah County, to the south quarter corner of**  
18 **section 22 and the point of beginning.**

19 **SECTION 2. ORS 201.260 is amended to read:**

20 201.260. The boundary of Multnomah County is as follows:

21 (1) Beginning at a point on the boundary of the state on the half-section line running east and  
22 west through the center of sections 22 and 23, township 3 north, range 1 west, Willamette Meridian;  
23 thence running westerly along the half-section line, through the center of section 23, until it inter-  
24 sects the section line running north and south between sections 22 and 23; thence southerly along  
25 the section line until it intersects the section line running east and west that divides sections 23  
26 and 26; thence westerly along the section line to a point in the middle of the second range of  
27 townships west of the Willamette Meridian; thence south by the section line to the center of the  
28 second township north of the base line; thence one mile south and one mile east, alternately, by  
29 section lines to **the northwest corner of section 22, township 1 north, range 1 west; thence**  
30 **south between sections 21 and 22 to the quarter corner between sections 21 and 22, that point**  
31 **also being the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section 22; thence east to the**

1 **center of section 22, that point being the northeast corner of the southwest quarter of sec-**  
 2 **tion 22; thence south following the center line of section 22 to the south quarter corner be-**  
 3 **tween sections 22 and 27, that point also being the southeast corner of the southwest quarter**  
 4 **of section 22; thence east between sections 22 and 27 to the southeast corner of section 22;**  
 5 **thence one mile south and one mile east, alternately, by section lines to the Willamette**  
 6 Meridian; thence south by the meridian line to the township line between townships 1 and 2 south  
 7 of the base line; thence east by the township line to the middle of the Willamette River; thence down  
 8 the middle of the Willamette River to the section line between sections 23 and 26, township 1 south,  
 9 range 1 east; thence east on section lines to the western boundary of Hood River County, as de-  
 10 scribed in ORS 201.140; thence northerly along such county boundary to the boundary of the state;  
 11 thence westerly along the boundary of the state to the place of beginning.

12 (2) Commencing at a point at the quarter post between sections 23 and 26, township 1 south,  
 13 range 1 east; thence east to the east line of the city of Sellwood; thence south along the east line  
 14 of the city of Sellwood to the southeast corner of the city; thence west and westerly along the south  
 15 line of the city to the center of the Willamette River; thence down the center of the river to the line  
 16 between sections 22 and 27, township 1 south, range 1 east; thence east along the line between  
 17 sections 22, 27, 23 and 26 to the place of beginning.

18 **SECTION 3.** ORS 201.340 is amended to read:

19 201.340. The boundary of Washington County is as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner  
 20 of section 1, township 3 south, range 1 west, Willamette Meridian; running thence north 13 miles;  
 21 thence one mile west; thence one mile north; thence one mile west; thence one mile north; *thence*  
 22 *one mile west; thence one mile north;* **to the southeast corner of section 22, township 1 north,**  
 23 **range 1 west; thence one half mile west to the south quarter corner of section 22, that point**  
 24 **also being the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of section 22; thence one half mile**  
 25 **north to the center of section 22, that point also being the northeast corner of the southwest**  
 26 **quarter of section 22; thence one half mile west to the west quarter corner of section 22, that**  
 27 **point also being the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section 22; thence one half**  
 28 **mile north to the northwest corner of section 22;** thence one mile west; thence one mile north;  
 29 thence one mile west; thence one mile north; thence one mile west; thence one mile north; thence  
 30 one mile west; thence one mile north; thence one mile west; thence one mile north; thence one mile  
 31 west; thence seven miles north; thence three miles west; thence one mile north; thence two miles  
 32 west; thence two miles north; thence 16 miles west; thence five miles south; thence six miles west;  
 33 thence two miles south; thence one mile east; thence one mile south; thence one mile east; thence  
 34 one mile south; thence one mile east; thence one mile south; thence two miles east; thence one mile  
 35 south; thence two miles east; thence one mile south; thence two miles east; thence one mile south;  
 36 thence one mile west; thence one mile south; thence two miles west; thence two miles south; thence  
 37 two miles west; thence one mile south; thence one mile west; thence one mile south; thence one mile  
 38 west; thence two miles south; thence one mile west; thence three miles south; thence one mile west;  
 39 thence one mile south; thence 17 miles east; thence one mile south; thence one mile east; thence one  
 40 mile south; thence four miles east; thence one mile south; thence one mile east; thence one mile  
 41 south; thence one mile east; thence one mile south; thence one mile east; thence one mile south;  
 42 thence three miles east; thence two miles south; thence three miles east; thence two miles north;  
 43 thence two miles east; thence one mile south; thence three miles east to the place of beginning.

44 **SECTION 4.** This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
 45 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
