

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2370

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 15 through 29 and insert:

2 “(a) The department shall post on the Oregon transparency website notices of public meetings
3 required to be provided by the state agency under ORS 192.640. If the state agency maintains a
4 website where minutes or summaries of the public meetings are available, the state agency shall
5 provide the department with the link to that website for posting on the Oregon transparency
6 website.

7 “(b) The department shall post on the Oregon transparency website a link for the website
8 maintained by the Secretary of State for rules adopted by the state agency. If the state agency
9 maintains a website where the rules of the agency are posted, or where any information relating to
10 the rules of the agency is posted, the state agency shall provide the department with the link to that
11 website for posting on the Oregon transparency website.

12 “(c) The department shall provide links on the Oregon transparency website for information re-
13 ceived by the department regarding contracts and subcontracts entered into by a state agency or
14 education service district, to the extent disclosure of that information is allowed by law and the
15 information is already available on websites maintained by the state agency or education service
16 district. To the extent available, the information linked to under this section must include:”.

17 On page 3, delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

18 “(7) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall include on the Oregon transpar-
19 ency website a page that provides links to websites established by local governments, as defined in
20 ORS 174.116, and by special government bodies, as defined in ORS 174.117, for the purpose of pro-
21 viding transparency in the revenues, expenditures and budgets of the public bodies. The department
22 shall include a link to the website of the public body upon receiving a request from the public body,
23 and shall consider recommendations from the Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission for the
24 inclusion of other links to local and special government body websites. The department shall include
25 a prominent link on the home page of the Oregon transparency website for information posted to
26 the page described in this subsection.”.

27 On page 4, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

28 “(6) In addition to the information described in subsection (3) of this section, the Oregon De-
29 partment of Administrative Services shall post on the Oregon transparency website copies of all
30 reports that the department, the Department of Revenue or the Oregon Business Development De-
31 partment receives from counties and other local governments relating to properties in enterprise
32 zones that have received tax exemptions under ORS 285C.170, 285C.175 or 285C.409, or that are el-
33 igible for tax exemptions under ORS 285C.309, 315.507 or 317.124 by reason of being in an enterprise
34 zone. The reports shall be submitted to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services in a
35 manner and format prescribed by the department.”.
