## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2387

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete line 27.

2	On page 2, delete lines 1 through 31 and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Historical Society shall solicit donations and undertake a
4	fund-raising campaign to raise moneys for:
5	"(a) The selection of a sculptor and the commissioning of a design and the production
6	of a sculpture of Mark Odom Hatfield, including the creation of a pedestal and any desired
7	inscription;
8	"(b) The transportation of the statue and pedestal to the United States Capitol;
9	"(c) The temporary display of the statue in the Rotunda of the United States Capitol
10	during any unveiling ceremony to be held;
11	"(d) Other costs associated with the unveiling ceremony;
12	"(e) The costs of removal of the statue of Jason Lee from National Statuary Hall in the
13	United States Capitol, transportation of the Jason Lee statue to Salem, Oregon, and instal-
14	lation of the Jason Lee statue at a suitable location identified by the society; and
15	"(f) Any other expenses the society incurs in implementing this section.
16	"(2) Upon enactment of this section, the Executive Director of the Oregon Historical
17	Society, or the executive director's designee, shall:
18	"(a) Undertake the fund-raising campaign described in subsection (1) of this section;
19	"(b) Within six months following enactment of this section, write to the Architect of the
20	Capitol apprising the architect of the interest of the State of Oregon in replacing the statue
21	of Jason Lee in National Statuary Hall in the United States Capitol with a statue of Mark
22	Odom Hatfield and requesting the architect to seek the approval of the Joint Committee on
23	the Library of Congress for the statue replacement; and
24	"(c) Convey all information received from the Architect of the Capitol about the statue
25	replacement project to the Governor or the Governor's designee.
26	"(3) As soon as is practicable after the date on which the society determines that it has
27	obtained sufficient funding to undertake the project described in subsection (1) of this sec-
28	tion, the society shall seek proposals from qualified sculptors and undertake whatever other
29	measures are necessary to complete the project described in subsection (1) of this section
30	The society shall follow the direction of the Architect of the Capitol in completing the project
31	described in subsection (1) of this section.".
