

House Bill 2438

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Energy, Environment and Water)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides, for waste plastics that cannot be economically recycled, that conversion of such waste plastics to oil using pyrolysis is considered recycling for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to waste plastics; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 459.005 to**
5 **459.437.**

6 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of ORS 459.015, and for the purpose**
7 **of encouraging the manufacture of new products or materials, other than fuel, from waste**
8 **plastics that cannot be otherwise economically recycled, the conversion of such waste plas-**
9 **tics to oil using pyrolysis shall be considered recycling under ORS 459.015 (2)(a)(C).**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
