

House Bill 2523

Sponsored by Representative THOMPSON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study and report to Legislative Assembly on duplicative reporting requirements imposed by state on managed care organizations, coordinated care organization and hospitals.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reporting requirements imposed by state on health care providers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study the reporting requirements**
5 **imposed on managed care organizations, coordinated care organizations and hospitals, by**
6 **rule or under contracts entered into by the authority, to determine whether any of the re-**
7 **quirements duplicate other reporting requirements imposed on these entities by the author-**
8 **ity, the Department of Human Services or any other state agency. The authority shall report**
9 **its findings to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than**
10 **January 1, 2015.**

11 **(2) The authority may contract with a private organization to conduct the study and**
12 **prepare a draft report in accordance with this section.**

13 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed January 2, 2015.**
