House Bill 2523

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study and report to Legislative Assembly on duplicative reporting requirements imposed by state on managed care organizations, coordinated care organization and hospitals.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to reporting requirements imposed by state on health care providers. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study the reporting requirements imposed on managed care organizations, coordinated care organizations and hospitals, by 5 rule or under contracts entered into by the authority, to determine whether any of the re-6 quirements duplicate other reporting requirements imposed on these entities by the author-8 ity, the Department of Human Services or any other state agency. The authority shall report its findings to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than 9 10 January 1, 2015. (2) The authority may contract with a private organization to conduct the study and 11

prepare a draft report in accordance with this section.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed January 2, 2015.

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
