

# House Bill 2601

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Judiciary)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals restriction on use of photographs taken using photo red light camera.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to photo red light; creating new provisions; and repealing ORS 810.435.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. ORS 810.435 is repealed.**

**SECTION 2. The repeal of ORS 810.435 by section 1 of this 2013 Act applies to photographs taken on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
