SUMMARY

Provides that postpartum mother [and certain persons] may remove placenta from health care facility [in certain cases] pursuant to rules adopted by Oregon Health Authority.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 459.400 is amended to read:
5	459.400. The requirements of ORS 459.386 to 459.405 [shall] do not apply to:
6	(1) Waste, other than sharps as defined in ORS 459.386, that is:
7	[(1)] (a) Generated in the practice of veterinary medicine; and
8	[(2)] (b) Not capable of being communicated by invasion and multiplication in body tissues and
9	capable of causing disease or adverse health impacts in humans.
10	(2) The removal from a health care facility as defined in ORS 442.015 of a placenta by a
11	postpartum mother pursuant to rules adopted by the Oregon Health Authority.
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
