

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2644

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘public education program’ means an education**
- 3 **program provided by any of the following:**
- 4 **“(a) A school district;**
- 5 **“(b) A public charter school;**
- 6 **“(c) An education service district;**
- 7 **“(d) A long term care or treatment facility, as described in ORS 343.961;**
- 8 **“(e) The Youth Corrections Education Program; or**
- 9 **“(f) The Oregon School for the Deaf.**
- 10 **“(2) For each school year, the Department of Education shall require public education**
- 11 **programs to submit the following information about students in kindergarten through grade**
- 12 **12 classes:**
- 13 **“(a) The total number of students in the classes; and**
- 14 **“(b) The total number of licensed or registered teachers regularly assigned to the stu-**
- 15 **dents counted under paragraph (a) of this subsection.**
- 16 **“(3) By February 1 of the year following the school year described in subsection (2) of this**
- 17 **section, the Department of Education shall make the information received under subsection**
- 18 **(2) of this section available to:**
- 19 **“(a) The public on the website of the Department of Education; and**
- 20 **“(b) The Legislative Assembly through annual reports.**
- 21 **“(4) For the purpose of this section, the State Board of Education shall identify by rule:**
- 22 **“(a) The definition of what constitutes a class for which a public education program must**
- 23 **report;**
- 24 **“(b) The definition of what constitutes regular assignment of teachers to students for**
- 25 **purposes of subsection (2)(b) of this section;**
- 26 **“(c) The categories of classes for which a public education program must report; and**
- 27 **“(d) If possible, the source of an existing data set that may be used to satisfy the re-**
- 28 **quirements of this section.**
- 29 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act first applies to information submitted by public**
- 30 **education programs for the 2014-2015 school year.”.**
