

House Bill 2659

Sponsored by Representative FREDERICK (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study issues related to contaminated properties and to report to certain interim legislative committees on or before November 1, 2013.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to contaminated properties; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall study issues related to**
5 **contaminated properties in this state, including:**

6 (a) **Proposals to establish a grant program to provide grants for the cleanup of contam-**
7 **inated properties.**

8 (b) **Proposals to enhance efficiencies in the cleanup of contaminated properties.**

9 (2) **The department shall submit a report with the results of the study, and include rec-**
10 **ommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related**
11 **to environment and natural resources on or before November 1, 2013.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
