

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2667

By COMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 8 and 9 and insert:  
2 “(B) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS  
3 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business.”  
4 Delete lines 12 and 13 and insert:  
5 “(B) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS  
6 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business.”  
7 Delete lines 15 and 16 and insert:  
8 “(A) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS  
9 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business;”  
10 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 10.  
11 In line 11, delete “(e)” and insert “(c)”.  
12 In line 12, delete the period and insert “; and  
13 “(d) Report the results of the study the task force conducts under paragraph (a) of this sub-  
14 section in a manner that makes comprehensive data about public contracting awards to minority-  
15 owned, woman-owned or emerging small businesses in this state visible, understandable and useable  
16 and that illuminates the particular impact that contracting agencies’ public contracting practices  
17 have on:  
18 “(A) Minority-owned businesses, woman-owned businesses and emerging small businesses, each  
19 as separate categories of businesses; and  
20 “(B) Specific groups of minority individuals who own small or local businesses, including but not  
21 limited to individuals who are:  
22 “(i) Asian American, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(c), or Pacific Islander;  
23 “(ii) Black, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(a), or African American;  
24 “(iii) Hispanic, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(b), or Latino;  
25 “(iv) Portuguese, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(d);  
26 “(v) American Indian or Alaskan Native, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(e); and  
27 “(vi) A member of another group that the Advocate for Minority, Women and Emerging Small  
28 Business has determined is socially and economically disadvantaged.”  
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
