

House Bill 2668

Sponsored by Representative FREDERICK (at the request of Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries Brad Avakian) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands definition of "place of public accommodation" to include places owned or maintained by public body and services provided by public body.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public accommodations; amending ORS 659A.400.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 659A.400 is amended to read:

5 659A.400. (1) A place of public accommodation, subject to the exclusion in subsection (2) of this
6 section, means:

7 (a) Any place or service offering to the public accommodations, advantages, facilities or privi-
8 leges whether in the nature of goods, services, lodgings, amusements or otherwise.

9 (b) **Any place that is open to the public and owned or maintained by a public body, as**
10 **defined in ORS 174.109, regardless of whether the place is commercial in nature.**

11 (c) **Any service to the public that is provided by a public body, as defined in ORS 174.109,**
12 **regardless of whether the service is commercial in nature.**

13 (2) [*However,*] A place of public accommodation does not include any institution, bona fide club
14 or place of accommodation [*which*] **that** is in its nature distinctly private.
