

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2710

June 25

(No change in Measure Summary)

Speaker Kotek:

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred A-engrossed House Bill 2710, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the House concur in the Senate amendments dated June 5 and that the bill be amended as follows and repassed.

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 14, after the semicolon insert “or”.

2 Delete lines 15 through 22 and insert:

3 “(b) The law enforcement agency has probable cause to believe that a person has committed a
4 crime, is committing a crime or is about to commit a crime, and exigent circumstances exist that
5 make it unreasonable for the law enforcement agency to obtain a warrant authorizing use of a
6 drone.”.

7 On page 3, delete lines 11 through 14 and insert:

8 “**SECTION 7. (1) A law enforcement agency may operate a drone for the purpose of**
9 **training in:**

10 “(a) **The use of drones; and**

11 “(b) **The acquisition of information through the operation of a drone.**

12 “(2) **Any image or other information that is acquired through the use of a drone by a law**
13 **enforcement agency under this section, and any evidence derived from that image or infor-**
14 **mation:**

15 “(a) **Is not admissible in, and may not be disclosed in, a judicial proceeding, administra-**
16 **tive proceeding, arbitration proceeding or other adjudicatory proceeding; and**

17 “(b) **May not be used to establish reasonable suspicion or probable cause to believe that**
18 **an offense has been committed.”.**
