SUMMARY

Authorizes pharmacy to perform certain tests and examinations if pharmacy obtains waiver from United States Department of Health and Human Services and complies with applicable federal regulations.

2 Relating to federal waivers for laboratories.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 689.

5 SECTION 2. (1) A pharmacy may perform the tests and examinations described in sub-

section (2) of this section if the pharmacy obtains a waiver from the United States Depart ment of Health and Human Services pursuant to 42 C.F.R. 493.35 and complies with the

8 requirements of 42 C.F.R. 493.35, 493.37 and 493.39.

9 (2) Tests and examinations authorized under this section include any test or examination 10 related to an analyte that the United States Food and Drug Administration has cleared under

11 **42 C.F.R. 493.15.**

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
