

# House Bill 2714

Sponsored by Representative CAMERON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes pharmacy to perform certain tests and examinations if pharmacy obtains waiver from United States Department of Health and Human Services and complies with applicable federal regulations.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to federal waivers for laboratories.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 689.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A pharmacy may perform the tests and examinations described in sub-**  
6 **section (2) of this section if the pharmacy obtains a waiver from the United States Depart-**  
7 **ment of Health and Human Services pursuant to 42 C.F.R. 493.35 and complies with the**  
8 **requirements of 42 C.F.R. 493.35, 493.37 and 493.39.**

9 **(2) Tests and examinations authorized under this section include any test or examination**  
10 **related to an analyte that the United States Food and Drug Administration has cleared under**  
11 **42 C.F.R. 493.15.**
