House Bill 2816

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study certain issues related to carbon dioxide emissions from motor vehicles. Sunsets January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to carbon dioxide emissions; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall undertake a study of 5 issues related to the damage to public health and the environment from the carbon dioxide 6 emissions of automobiles, trucks and other motor vehicles. The study must include an anal-7 ysis of the amount of carbon dioxide emitted in this state by motor vehicles and an assess-

8 ment of the effects of the carbon dioxide emissions from motor vehicles on public health and

9 the environment.

(2) The department shall report the results of the study to the interim committees of the
Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before November
1, 2013.

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.

SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
