

# House Bill 2816

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study certain issues related to carbon dioxide emissions from motor vehicles.

Sunsets January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to carbon dioxide emissions; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall undertake a study of**  
5 **issues related to the damage to public health and the environment from the carbon dioxide**  
6 **emissions of automobiles, trucks and other motor vehicles. The study must include an anal-**  
7 **ysis of the amount of carbon dioxide emitted in this state by motor vehicles and an assess-**  
8 **ment of the effects of the carbon dioxide emissions from motor vehicles on public health and**  
9 **the environment.**

10 **(2) The department shall report the results of the study to the interim committees of the**  
11 **Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before November**  
12 **1, 2013.**

13 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
16 **on its passage.**
