

# House Bill 2837

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases allocation to Department of Corrections from Criminal Fine Account for planning, operating and maintaining county juvenile and adult corrections programs and facilities.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Criminal Fine**  
5 **Account, the allocation to the Department of Corrections established by section 58 (2),**  
6 **chapter 597, Oregon Laws 2011, for the period beginning January 1, 2012, and ending June 30,**  
7 **2013, for the purpose of planning, operating and maintaining county juvenile and adult cor-**  
8 **rections programs and facilities, is increased by \$3,053,176.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
