## House Bill 2851

Sponsored by Representative BARKER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires imposition of sentencing enhancement of 36 to 60 months upon conviction of gangrelated felony.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 161.605, the court shall sentence a person who is convicted of a felony to a term of imprisonment that is 36 to 60 months longer than the presumptive or mandatory minimum sentence, whichever would otherwise be imposed, if the person committed the crime:
    - (a)(A) For the benefit, or at the direction, of a criminal street gang; or
- (B) In association with a criminal street gang; and
- 10 **(b) With the intent to:** 
  - (A) Assist in criminal conduct by criminal street gang members;
- 12 (B) Promote the criminal street gang; or
  - (C) Further the purposes of the criminal street gang.
  - (2) If the sentence otherwise required by law under subsection (1) of this section is a sentence of probation, the court shall sentence the person who committed the crime under the circumstances described in subsection (1) of this section to a term of imprisonment of 36 to 60 months.
  - (3) The facts required to be found to sentence a defendant under this section are enhancement facts, as defined in ORS 136.760, and ORS 136.765 to 136.785 apply to making determinations of those facts.
    - (4) As used in this section:
    - (a) "Criminal street gang" means a group of at least three persons that has:
- 23 (A) As one of its primary activities the commission of criminal acts or acts that if committed by an adult would constitute criminal acts;
  - (B) A common name, common style of dress or common identifying signs, colors or symbols; and
  - (C) At least two members who engage in or have engaged in a pattern of criminal street gang activity.
    - (b) "Pattern of criminal street gang activity" means the commission of, or an attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit, on separate occasions within a three-year period:
    - (A) At least two felony offenses;

- (C) At least one felony and two misdemeanor offenses; or
- (D) A comparable number of acts that if committed by an adult would constitute misdemeanors or felonies.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act applies to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
