## House Bill 2855

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires person claiming property by adverse possession to hold hostile possession of property with color of title based on written conveyance.

<b>2</b>	Relating to adverse possession of property; amending ORS 105.618 and 105.620.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 105.620 is amended to read:
5	105.620. (1) A person may acquire fee simple title to real property by adverse possession only
6	if:
7	(a) The person, and the predecessors in interest of the person, have maintained actual, open,
8	notorious, exclusive, hostile and continuous possession of the property for a period of 10 years;
9	(b) At the time the person claiming by adverse possession, or the person's predecessors in in-
10	terest, first entered into possession of the property, the person entering into possession had the
11	honest belief that the person was the actual owner of the property and that belief:
12	(A) By the person, and the person's predecessor in interest, continued throughout the vesting
13	period;
14	(B) Had an objective basis; and
15	(C) Was reasonable under the particular circumstances; and
16	(c) The person proves each of the elements set out in this section by clear and convincing evi-
17	dence.
18	(2)(a) A person maintains "hostile possession" of property if the possession is [under claim of
19	right or] with color of title. ["Color of title" means the adverse possessor claims under a written
20	conveyance of the property or by operation of law from one claiming under a written conveyance.]
21	(b) Absent additional supporting facts, the grazing of livestock is insufficient to satisfy the re-
22	quirements of subsection (1)(a) of this section.
23	(3) As used in this section, "color of title" means the adverse possessor claims under a
24	written conveyance of the property or by operation of law from one claiming under a written
25	conveyance.
26	[(3)] (4) As used in this section and ORS 105.005 and 105.615, "person" includes, but is not lim-
27	ited to, the state and its political subdivisions as created by statute.
28	SECTION 2. ORS 105.618 is amended to read:
29	105.618. A person may not acquire by adverse possession, as [defined] described in ORS 105.620,
30	property owned by a railroad or used for a railroad operation.
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
