

# House Bill 2865

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Outcomes-Based Funding for Education.  
Sunsets on date of convening of 2015 legislative session.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to outcomes-based funding for education; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Outcomes-Based Funding for Education is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of six members appointed as follows:**

6 **(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint three members from among members of the**  
7 **Senate.**

8 **(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three members from**  
9 **among members of the House of Representatives.**

10 **(3)(a) The task force shall conduct hearings and request any reports necessary from the**  
11 **Oregon Education Investment Board to determine the level of success of outcomes-based**  
12 **funding for education in actual practice.**

13 **(b) As a result of the information received by the task force under paragraph (a) of this**  
14 **subsection, the task force shall determine whether to recommend legislation that allows**  
15 **outcomes-based funding for education only as part of a year-long pilot program involving a**  
16 **small sample of educational entities.**

17 **(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction**  
18 **of business.**

19 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**  
20 **of the task force.**

21 **(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

22 **(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**  
23 **ment to become immediately effective.**

24 **(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**  
25 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

26 **(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

27 **(10) The task force may pre-session file legislation in the manner provided in ORS 171.130**  
28 **for interim committees. All legislation recommended by official action of the task force must**  
29 **indicate that it is introduced at the request of the task force.**

30 **(11) The task force shall report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in**  
31 **ORS 192.245 at any time within 30 days after its final meeting or at such later time as the**

1 **President and Speaker may designate.**

2 (12) **The Legislative Administrator may employ persons necessary for the performance**  
3 **of the functions of the task force. The Legislative Administrator shall fix the duties and**  
4 **amounts of compensation of these employees. The task force shall use the services of con-**  
5 **tinuing legislative staff, without employing additional persons, to the greatest extent practi-**  
6 **cable.**

7 (13) **All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**  
8 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**  
9 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**  
10 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015**  
12 **regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
15 **on its passage.**

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
