

# Enrolled House Bill 2871

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON REVENUE

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to tax compliance; and prescribing an effective date.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** The Department of Revenue shall report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue, no later than February 1, 2014, on its progress in implementing the pilot project described in section 2, chapter 576, Oregon Laws 2009. The report shall:

(1) Include a plan to further develop and improve the pilot project based upon evidence obtained by the department during implementation of the pilot project and upon the department's experience during implementation.

(2) Recommend methods by which the pilot project could be expanded to include other state agencies, boards or commissions in an efficient and feasible manner.

**SECTION 2.** This 2013 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2013 regular session of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
