Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study of geological opportunities in Oregon and present report to Legislative Assembly by February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries shall conduct
5	a study of geological opportunities in Oregon and present the results of the study in a report
6	to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 on or before February 1
7	of each odd-numbered year.
8	(2) The department shall post the report prepared pursuant to subsection (1) of this
9	section on the department's website.
