

# House Bill 2969

Sponsored by Representative KOMP; Representative THOMPSON, Senator BATES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires insurer that provides coverage of ambulance care and transportation to indemnify provider of ambulance care and transportation directly.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to insurance coverage of ambulance services; creating new provisions; and amending ORS  
3 743A.014.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.014 is amended to read:

6 743A.014. [*Any insurance policy issued or issued for delivery in this state*] **Notwithstanding ORS**  
7 **743.543, with respect to a health insurance policy** that provides coverage for ambulance care and  
8 transportation [*shall provide that payments will be made jointly to*], **the insurer shall indemnify**  
9 **directly** the provider of the ambulance care and transportation [*and to the insured, unless the policy*  
10 *provides for direct payment to the provider*].

11 **SECTION 2.** **The amendments to ORS 743A.014 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to**  
12 **claims presented on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**

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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
