House Bill 2969

SUMMARY

Requires insurer that provides coverage of ambulance care and transportation to indemnify provider of ambulance care and transportation directly.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 743A.014 is amended to read:
6	743A.014. [Any insurance policy issued or issued for delivery in this state] Notwithstanding ORS
7	743.543, with respect to a health insurance policy that provides coverage for ambulance care and
8	transportation [shall provide that payments will be made jointly to], the insurer shall indemnify
9	directly the provider of the ambulance care and transportation [and to the insured, unless the policy
10	provides for direct payment to the provider].
11	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 743A.014 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to
12	claims presented on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
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
